We are very pleased this year that the Churchdown Male Voice Choir has offered to sing for us. Formed in 1965 in Churchdown near Gloucester, the choir takes its members from all over the counties of Gloucestershire and Herefordshire.

In the last few years the choir has had the great privilege of appearing with orchestras, choirs, brass and military bands and in concerts with the English Association of Male Voice Choirs and National Association of Choirs. The choir has also shared the platform with such luminaries as Dame Shirley Bassey, Dame Vera Lynn, Sir Cliff Richard, Sir Tom Jones, Max Boyce, Dennis O'Neil and other major stars.

Under its conductor Ralph Barnes and accompanist James Quinn, the choir performs as many as 20 concerts a year raising money for local and national charities.

## KATE'S HOME NURSING

Kate's Home Nursing is a charity providing palliative nursing care for local people whose preference is to remain in their own home during the last stages of illness. We support our patients' loved ones during our time with them and have recently begun to offer bereavement support.

We work closely with GPs, District Nurses and other health and social care providers to fulfil a local need that, because of the rural location of some of our communities, larger charities are often unable to meet.

This year we will need to raise in the region of £300,000, around 30% of which is likely to be raised through NHS grants. Therefore we will depend on the support we receive from the communities we serve.
